Deborah welcomed several invited guests: Laura Northern, Ashley Davis, Cathy McMahan and Lori Satterwhite.

Donna Pugh discussed our past area project and we all agreed that Donna should write another grant to see if we can get funds to help with our next project. We will begin looking at names for scholarship recipients from the local high schools. We were reminded that applicants need to put 'Education' as their major to be considered for the DKG scholarship. Deborah also reminded the chapter that we are looking for new chapter officers. If any members are interested in being consider for an officer position please let your intentions be known, the decision for chapter officers will need to be made at the March meeting.

Ann Gregory gave the treasurers report and read the list of members who are paid up to date including the SPC scholarship donations. Ann indicated that we need to find a new, local bank. The bank we have now has been using charging us for every deposit and check that is written. There are certain rules due to our non-profit status.

Shalan Inmon began her presentation on the State Theme of 'Bridging Yesterday and Tomorrow'. She spoke about the State DKG Convention in Waco this year, June 14-16, 2018. Some of the updates include a Texas themed BBQ dinner. She also indicated that the 'Pace' award has been suspended for the time being.

She went on to talk about the international DKG convention that will be held in Austin. The Texas chapters will be he ambassadors. It was recommended that we attend on Monday and Tuesday if at all possible. Monday is the opening ceremony and Monday night is the 'Texas' night. Tuesday there is a luncheon scheduled. They anticipate 2000 members in attendance from around the world. Our chapter was asked to create 15-20 note cards that will be on the tables to 'Welcome to the 2018 DKG International Convention'.

Shalan went on to tell us about the moneys that were disbursed from the DKG emergency fund to any member affected by the hurricane. Funds were granted in the amount of \$500 per request.

As Deborah closed our meeting, she read a short excerpt to recognize our DKG beginnings and celebrate our 51st birthday. Deborah led us in the reading of the DKG collect and the meeting was adjourned. All present were invited to share in a luncheon of soup and salad.
