

What is Leadership Seminar?

Leadership Seminar is an intensive leadership training experience for 30 TSO members held the second year of every biennium in February. Founded in 1993, Leadership Seminar has enhanced leadership skills of over 400 members throughout the state. The overall goal of the seminar is to provide opportunities for professional and personal growth beneficial to both the individual member and the Society.

What can I expect from the experience?

During the Seminar, participants will discover the strengths they already possess as leaders and learn of the multitude of ways to be a strong leader. The training will be useful in our organization as well as applicable for use in homes, schools, and communities. Participants will depart Leadership Seminar having bonded with their Leadership class and making lasting friendships throughout the state.

How do I apply?

Application forms are online at the TSO Leadership Seminar webpage. Completed applications and the recommendation form are due by **October 15**. These must be sent electronically to the email address indicated. The recommendation form must be completed by your chapter president. If you will be serving as chapter president, please have a recent chapter president complete it.

When and where will Leadership Seminar 2021 be held?

The dates for the next Leadership Seminar are February 26-28, 2021, and it will be held at the Arlington Hilton Hotel. The Seminar begins on Friday in the late afternoon and ends by noon on Sunday so that our members still working will only miss a minimum amount of time away from their jobs.

What expenses are participants expected to pay?

By December 1, applicants will receive a letter of acceptance or encouragement to apply again next biennium. All information will be communicated electronically. If you receive an acceptance letter, you will be asked to begin preparing for the seminar by reading a specific book related to leadership. Additionally, there is a \$90 fee to help offset the expense of your hotel room, all meals from Friday night through Sunday morning, meeting rooms, and materials. All participants will need to pay for their own transportation expenses.

Is there anything I can begin doing now?

Yes, begin taking steps now to gather information and create your DKG resume. Your DKG bio/resume should be a timeline of the things you have done since your initiation. This includes committees, offices, attendance at workshops, conferences, and conventions. Begin with your chapter yearbooks to help you recall how you served. Once you begin this document, keep it for continued use throughout your years in DKG.

The Leadership Seminar Committee looks forward to discussing the opportunity and answering questions. For more information on applying for Leadership Seminar, please plan to attend your Area Workshop.
